I know how deeply you care for kids with cancer and adults too who rely on Answers for Angels. Patients battling cancer & other diseases are extremely susceptible to contagious viruses. Thanks to supporters like you, AFA is doing everything possible to continue our program to them.

Answers for Angels could not have accomplished all that we have if it weren't for your amazing generosity, from the community of supporters & volunteers that we embrace as partners in bringing about all of the year's triumphs & tribulations.

Our all-volunteer nonprofit organization was busy with efforts to strengthen our mission, with a couple of setbacks, that included:

- Hosting our 4th annual Answers for Angels 5k race for the first time at the Old Plank Trail in Frankfort, Illinois on October 19, 2019. Unfortunately, this event did not raise the goal amount of \$10,000.
- However, we did save \$1,300 in fundraising efforts by having the AFA5k at the Old Plank Trail in Frankfort, IL instead of at McCarthy Park, Tinley Park, IL.
- Unsolicited donations & an online year-end 'Giving Tuesday' Facebook fundraiser helped to reach the AFA5k goal, but we are still \$5,000 under our goal for the year.
- Presenting Ann Leonard of Mokena, Illinois the \$500 November Lung Cancer Awareness award in memory of Chuck Eaheart & James Hawes.
- Continually working with grant writers to expand our program to receive \$30,000 in funding from foundations. Unfortunately, we are coming up short on this endeavor to increase foundations supporting our program

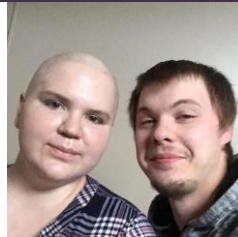
We're stronger together & we appreciate your willingness to be a part of the collaborative effort.

Answers for Angels has raised funds for children, adults, & families since 2009. The main method of our fundraising is the annual AFA 5k Race. With money raised:

- For younger patients we provide a gift/gift cards to their favorite store to animate the child & to improve their spirits as they cope with cancer & cancer treatments.
- We provide Well-being Grants to patients seeking alternative/integrative treatments while following conventional methods. Our grant pays for a consultation with integrative oncologists, supplements, & practitioners that many health insurance policies do not cover. For patients following conventional methods, we provide gift cards/certificates or pay a small bill in the patient's name.
- We help many patients who face financial hardships because of increased cost of medical bills & because they are unable to work due to aggressive cancer treatment & schedule.
